The Sakatti ore deposit is located underneath the Viiankiaapa Mire Protection Area. The area is also part of the Natura 2000 network of protected areas. The mine will be an underground development, and no aboveground structures will be located in the Natura 2000 area.

We believe that the Sakatti mine can be built and operated sustainably and with all due care for the environment. Sakatti's Environmental Impact Assessment includes a separate Natura assessment, a reindeer-herding study, a hydrological assessment, a study of voluntary ecological compensation measures, and a social impact assessment.
