Geita, is located in north-western Tanzania, in the Lake Victoria goldfields of the Mwanza region, about 120km from Mwanza and 4km west of the town of Geita.

The mine is an underground operation following completion of open-pit mining in the third quarter of 2020. Further open-pit development continued during 2021. The mine is serviced by a CIL processing plant with an annual capacity of 5.1Mt.

Geita is one of the five AngloGold Ashanti operations in Africa.
