If the 'recruiter' offers job training in return for money, know that you are being scammed. No legitimate company or recruiter would ask for money upfront, under any circumstances. Hernic regards these acts with the contempt they deserve. As Hernic owns no assets (mines and smelters) anymore, Hernic will not embark on any recruitment process. All members of the community are urged to be vigilant and report these matters to relevant authorities. Job-seekers are encouraged to make sure that they understand all the important details about looking for employment.
