Liddell Open Cut

Liddell Open Cut is an established mine, approved to produce up to 8 million tonnes of ROM coal per annum. Semi-soft and thermal coal is exported through Port of Newcastle.

Ownership

Liddell Open Cut is owned through a joint venture between Glencore (67.5%) and Mitsui Matsushima Australia Pty Limited (MMA) (32.5%).

Liddell Coal Operations Pty Ltd (Liddell Coal), a 100%-owned entity of Glencore, manages the operation on behalf of the joint venture.

Liddell Open Cut mine is located within the Hunter Coalfields at Ravensworth in the Upper Hunter Valley of New South Wales, approximately 25 kilometres northwest of Singleton, and 26 kilometres southeast of Muswellbrook.

- 1923** Underground operations commenced.
- 1946** Open Cut operations commenced.
- 1950** Continuous operation begins.
- 2002** Liddell Coal received development consent from Planning NSW (now Department of Planning & Infrastructure) to continue operations within the colliery holding.
- 2007** In July, Liddell Open Cut was granted a modification to the development consent, allowing an increase in the maximum total for run of mine coal production, an increase in the mining footprint, establishment of new supplementary coal stockpile, and realignment of approved access roads.
- 2014** Modification approved to extend mining footprint with Development Consent Boundary to maximise coal resource recovery, extending approved operations till 2028.
